	<p>Summariser: <i>The most important ideas are ... The main idea is ... This part was about ... First, Next, Then, ... This story takes place in ... The main characters are ... The problem of the story is ...</i> Using own words to describe and discuss main ideas and themes.</p>
	<p>Predictor: <i>I think I'll bet... I wonder if ... I imagine ... I suppose ... I predict ... I think this text will be about...</i> Using evidence in the text or illustrations, make predictions.</p>
