

Developing Early Writing

This session, led by Marianne McDonnell our EYFS Specialist Leader of Education, will look at how you can support your children in becoming confident writers. It will also explore some of challenges in engaging reluctant writers, especially boys.

This session will focus on the stages underpinning the development of children's writing; unpicking how they move from talking to writing and the skills they need for each. We will explore ways of assessing children's writing development and how to use this information to create a high quality learning



environment for continuous provision. The role of parents in supporting writing in the home will also be explored.



Practitioners will come away with a range of practical ideas and suggestions to develop approaches to writing in their own setting.
