

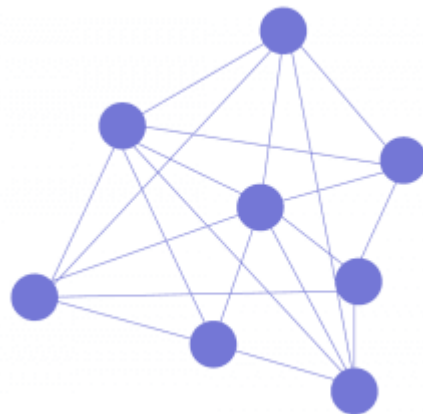
The Importance of Schema in Curriculum Design
